Learning Programme:

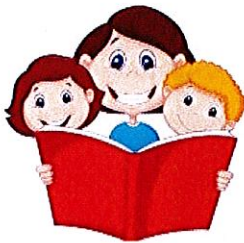
Swimming will take place every day for the first weeks of term while the weather is hot and Jacqui will continue to take private swimming lessons on Wednesday afternoons.
